Suits for Soldiers Event to Help Local Veterans Embark on a New Career in the Civilian Workforce

WHAT:

Dignity U Wear and Haven Hospice will host their first “Suits for Soldiers” event to provide new business suits for wounded veterans participating in the Wounded Warriors Project. Through a 12-month program, the Wounded Warrior Project provides an integrated approach to addresses long-term needs for education, training, advocacy and secondary rehabilitative care for wounded warriors. Upon completion of the program, soldiers are fitted for new business suits for use as they prepare to reenter the civilian workforce.

During the event, each veteran will be personally fitted with a new suit and accessories so that they will be fully prepared to enter the civilian workforce.
